

Document Requirements

- A. **Translation:** Any document submitted in support of an application and written in a language other than French or English must be accompanied by a translation true to the original completed by an accredited and duly sworn translator who may be any of the individuals listed below.

In Québec

- Member of the Ordre des traducteurs, terminologues et interprètes agréés du Québec

Abroad

- Translator for the embassy or consulate that issued the original document
- Professional translator

Please note that the translated documents must bear the name and seal of the translator, which must also be translated to be acceptable.

- B. **Certified true copy:** The certified true copy is one of the requirements that apply to the documents. It indicates that the copy of the document that you are submitting must necessarily be certified true to the original either by the issuer of the document or by a recognized authority in the country or territory where the document was issued.
